YTCTE Transportation Procedures

1. Carpool Drop-off and Pickup:

At Yeshiva Toras Chaim Toras Emes, our students' safety is our top priority. When driving carpool, please adhere to the following safety drop-off and pick-up procedures.

- All carpool cars must have a transponder attached to the windshield to be able to activate the opening of the gate. Transponders can be obtained from the front office.

-Enter the driveway at a speed of 5 MPH.

-Drive to the back of the parking lot and make a left to the back of the school building. Make a left at the basketball court to form a carpool line alongside the school building.

-Check all areas surrounding your car before pulling out at 5 miles per hour. Be cautious of student bike riders as you exit the school gate.

*If you come to school and cannot activate the front gate please ring the bell to the front office. If there is no answer, please park and use the walkway and gate to the left of the driveway.

2. Biking Information:

DACHS students are permitted to bike and scooter to and from school. All bikes and scooters are stored throughout the day in the designated area located on the left of the walk-in entrance. We strongly recommend that students chain their personal property to the bike racks as well. Bike racks and scooter charging outlets are available daily on a first come-first served basis.

We want all of our students to remain safe and out of harm's way!! Therefore, all students should wear helmets, reflectors, vests etc. Additionally, students should cross Miami Gardens Drive in the pedestrian crosswalk, and ONLY on a green light!

3. UBER:

We have designated the front of the Yeshiva building on Miami Gardens Drive, as a drop-off area. All Uber Pick-ups or drop-offs should be made on the large grass swale on Miami Gardens Drive, Past the 1st driveway. Passengers should get out of the car on the sidewalk and not the street. No Uber should ever block the Yeshiva's driveway. This causes a dangerous situation where cars are backed up on Miami Gardens Drive. Please help keep all of our Talmidim safe.
