Our Early Childhood Education (ECE) division represents the beginning of the education process. We invest in nurturing our students in all areas of development, providing the fundamental skills for lifelong learning and love of Torah. Through play, arts and crafts and hands-on learning, children experience the wonder and beauty of Jewish life and its values.



Our ECE educators design their curricula and classrooms to accommodate different learning styles and multiple intelligences. Instruction is individualized based on each child's needs. Fostering independence and engagement in the learning process, our educators help develop their students' unique strengths, and provide opportunities for growth through center-based activities, integrated study units and phonemic-based reading instruction. A primary goal of the ECE division is to develop and strengthen confidence, build social skills, and prepare the students for success in elementary school.

At Klurman Elementary (KES), we work to transform our bright, joyful, intellectually curious six year olds into educated, intellectually curious, happy, self-assured young people. We do this by focusing on the three dimensions of a child – academic, social and emotional, all within a Torah environment.

KES offers a comprehensive academic program that includes accelerated math tracks, balanced literacy, writer's workshop, *Limudei Kodesh* Enrichment for boys, Hebrew Language, as well as the ACE Resource Room Program. Cooperative Learning structures embedded in the daily lessons ensure maximum student engagement in academics, regardless of level. Through mastery of *kriah* and grammatical skills, in depth understanding of Torah and Talmudic concepts, and passionate, enthusiastic and loving *Rebbeim* and *Moros*, our students are excited about their Torah learning.

Social and emotional development are critical components in a child's self-esteem, and affect their ability to transition to a productive, balanced adulthood. YTCTE works hard to create a warm, kind, respectful and supportive environment that permeates our school, and employs the proactive "The Responsive Classroom®" approach to help each child feel significant and a part of something important, all while having fun.

We address the inevitable challenges of peer relations through social skills groups, mentoring programs and conflict resolution techniques. These aspects are a part of school life and are under the supervision of the school counselor.

rohr middle school

Rohr **M**iddle **S**chool, developed to address the specific needs of pre-teenage boys, is guided by a strong mission statement, “to ignite the GREATNESS within EVERY student.” The **RMS** mission statement and acronym clarifies our purpose to bring out each student’s inherent GREATNESS in the areas of **R**uchniyus, **M**idos and **S**cholarship.

Utilizing a cooperative learning style in the classrooms to maximize student engagement, RMS currently has three *Limudei Kodesh* classes for each grade level, including an advanced *shiur* with expanded hours of learning. All *Limudei Kodesh* classes are geared to building strong learning skills while simultaneously instilling a love of Hashem and His Torah. All General Studies classes are heterogeneously grouped and taught to the highest standards. We offer academic support within the regular school day by our very own teachers to ensure that each student is able to meet or exceed grade level expectations.

Our *talmidim* are invited to participate in exciting Torah programs such as Mishmar in the Morning, Shteig on a Sunday, Diamond Club (for davening and learning), Torah Cards, HP (*Hashgocha Protis*), and more. RMS believes that *talmidim* are truly successful when they are developing their *midos*. To this end, we clarify expectations and hold each student accountable to grow in his ability to model *derech erez*, accept responsibility, act with integrity, and be a positive influence within the classroom and school. As part of our leadership model, students meet with a leadership coach, who guides them in choosing and following through on their own personal goals in any area of **R**uchniyos, **M**idos or **S**cholarship. This process culminates with an inspirational eighth grade multi-media presentation that all students prepare upon graduation from Rohr Middle School.
