NURSERY I & II MOROT ETTIE & TAMI

A new unit on winter was started this week in the Nursery. The topic of snow, snowflakes and snowmen was very exciting for the children. We talked about the different kinds of winter garments that we wear such as hats, scarves, boots, jackets and coats. New Hebrew words taught this week include choref, sheleg, **ish sheleg, kova and me'il**. **Assembling snowmen out of paper circles** helped us learn about the concepts of small, medium and large.

A delightful song about snowmen was also taught to the children.


NURSERY I & II- MOROT NECHAMA & SUSAN

The sense of hearing was featured this week in the Afternoon Nursery. The children enjoyed decorating an ear and making a listening device out of styrofoam cups. The children listened to many different sounds and tried to identify them. Each child played a musical instrument in our marching band. We listened to the stories The Five Senses– Hearing by Maria Ruis, Sounds All Around by Jane Belk Moncure, The Five Senses by Alike, Splish, Splash Sounds by Richard Scarry, A First Book Of Sounds by Melanie Bellah and The Listening Walk by Paul Showers.

The children enjoyed singing many songs and dancing to aerobic music. The story Arroz Con Leche by Lulu Delacre was read to the children. They had a wonderful time dancing as they listened to a cassette featuring the songs from this book.

In conjunction with our unit on the Sense of Hearing, we learned the song "Do Your Ears Hang Low?"

PRE-KI, II & III- MOROT ETTIE & HEIDI

In Parashas Vayechi, we learned about the brachos that Yaakov gave to his sons and grandsons. We learned how Yaakov crossed his hands when he blessed Menashe and Efraim. We spoke about the many mitzvos that we do with our right hand. We sang **"Hamalach Hagoel"** and discussed the brachos that parents give their children on Friday night at the Shabbos table.

This week, the letter Yud was introduced. Some of the words we learned were : yeled (boy), yalda (girl), yareach (moon), yom (day), yom huledet (birthday), yad (hand) and yayin (wine). The children had fun tracing their yadaim for the letter yud and placed them in their aleph-bais books.

This week, we started a Hebrew language unit on Ochel and Brachos. We learned to identify the Hebrew names of many foods such as tapuach, tapuz, chalav, banana, mitz, beitzah and mayim. We also practiced saying the Hebrew phrases

PRE-KI, II & III- MOROT BERNEY & JUDY

This week, the Pre-K children continued their unit on Famous Artists. They learned about the techniques of the painter Monet who was an **impressionist**. **Words that related to Monet's art were** light, shadow, landscape, reflection, sunrise and nature. We discussed nature, wind, water and waves and how these elements were reflected in his paintings. A **famous painting that we looked at was "Waterloo Bridge."** The children sang the song "London Bridge's" and constructed their own bridges.

This week, we reviewed the letter "Dd" and introduced the letter "Ee". The children sounded out words such as egg, elephant and exit.

This week, we started a Science unit on the properties of air. The children were able to see how air can push solids as well as liquids. A new word that was **taught in conjunction with this unit was "pressure"**. We learned about air pressure and how it can cause objects to move.

The children in Pre-K practiced their number recognition skills through games and activities. They located and counted many exit signs in the preschool.

A favorite song that we learned this week was **"One Elephant."**

One elephant went out to play
On a spider's web one day
He had such enormous fun
That called for another elephant to come.

The stories that we listened to this week were Katie Visits The Impressionists by James Mayhew, Eggbert, The Slightly Cracked Egg by Tom Ross and The Eensy Weensy Spider by Mary Ann Hoberman.

KINDERGARTEN I & II- MOROT BAYLA & RENA

Though Chanukah is behind us, the excitement in Kindergarten never subsides. We started a fun and delicious unit on Brachos. We discussed the importance of thanking Hashem for the many wonderful things that He gives us. **We focused on the brachos “Borah Pri Hagafen” and “Hamotzi Lechem Min Ha’aretz”.** We made a beautiful Hamotzi project and created wine bottle necklaces in honor of the bracha of Hagafen. We enjoyed a special Hagafen and Hamotzi snack. We integrated the **Bracha unit with our D’vash V’chalav program. We learned the sentences “Mi rotzeh lechem? Mi rotzeh yayin?”**


The letter ches was introduced. Chanukiyah, chosson and chuppah were some familiar words that the children recognized starting with this letter. The middah of chessed was also stressed in conjunction with the letter ches. We listened to the story But Then I Remembered by Chaya Leah Rothstein which accentuates the importance of this middah.

For Parashas Vayechi, the children acted out the story of Yaakov Avinu blessing Efraim and Menashe and **sang the Tefillah “Hamalach Hagoel.”** We discussed the brachos which Yaakov gave to his children-the twelve shevatim.

We hope that all of the children are going to be in **shul this Shabbos so they can sing “Chazak, Chazak V’Nischazek” when Sefer Beraishis is completed.**

We discussed Asara B’Teves which commemorates the beginning of the destruction of the Bais Hamikdash.

In Project Derech, we learned the it is wrong to shame any person, especially a teacher or someone who is older. (However, if it is important to correct a mistake, you may ask a question in a way that they will not be embarrassed.)



KINDERGARTEN I & II- MOROT BERNEY & MIRIAM

What an interesting week our kindergartners had – one filled with various imaginative activities. The children are so excited now about reading because during the week, they were introduced to the word **“is.”** Now they can read many simple sentences such as **“Dad is ill”, “Sis is sad” and “Dog is odd”.**

In Math, we introduced the concept of measuring and stressed the inch ruler. The children really enjoyed measuring all kinds of objects with their rulers. We also made igloos with inch blocks.

In Science, the topic of insects was discussed. The children learned that insects are found all over the planet earth. They have three body parts– six legs, wings and antennae.

“li” is for imagination. This idea was reinforced with our reading of the book If You Give A Mouse A Cookie by Laura Numeroff. This was also the featured book in our listening center.

For the next three weeks, the topic of magnets will be discussed. This week, the children were introduced to magnets. They worked in the science center investigating which materials are attracted to a magnet. They learned that objects which have iron or steel in them are attracted by magnets.






