## NURSERY I & II MOROT ETTIE & TAMI

The Nursery children loved hearing the many beautiful midrashim about the life of Moshe Rabbenu—how he was placed in a teivat gomeh by his mother Yocheved and hidden in the river amongst the tall reeds. As Miriam watched her brother Moshe, Batya, the daughter of Paroh, came down to the river and heard Moshe cry. She reached out her hand and Hashem made a nes occur. Her hand stretched all the way to the teivah. We also learned how Bnei Yisroel became slaves and how Moshe Rabbenu was commanded by Hashem to lead Bnei Yisroel out of Mitzrayim. The children acted out the parsha and pretended to be slaves. They built the cities of Pitom and Ramses and **sang the song: “Bang, Bang, Hold Your Hammers Low.”**

Bang, Bang, Bang, hold your hammers low  
Bang, Bang, Bang, give a heavy blow  
**For it's work, work, work**  
Every day and every night (2x)  
Dig, dig, dig, your shovels deep  
Dig, dig, dig, there is no time to sleep.

**Our unit on winter was the focus of our week's** activities in the Nursery. We talked about weather conditions up north and **sang the song “Miami Has No Sheleg”:**

Miami has no sheleg  
No snow to roll and throw  
**Up north, where the weather's cold**  
**That's where you'll find snow.**

New Hebrew vocabulary words taught this week included the words kar, kefafot, tzaif and magafaim.

## NURSERY I & II- MOROT NECHAMA & SUSAN


This week, the Nursery focused on the sense of touch. We had an exciting time doing experiments. We washed clothing with soap and water and compared how they felt when they were wet and when they were dry. **We made handprints and also created “touch” picture** using many different textures. We had a fabulous time with our hands. We felt, touched and smoothed shaving cream over the tables.

We listened to the stories The Five Senses by Maria Ruis, Find Out By Touching by Paul Showers, Five Senses by Tasha Tudor and The Touch Book by Jane Belk Moncure.

During center time, we counted objects on the flannel board. We also counted with math sticks. Outdoors, we had a great time doing parachute activities. We danced and sang many songs as we held the parachute. What fun!

**We sang the song “This Is The Way We Wash Our Hands:”**

Wash our hands, wash our hands

So early in the morning.



PRE-KI, II & III- MOROT ETTIE & HEIDI

In Parashas Shemos, we learned that Bnei Yisroel didn't change their Jewish names. Beautiful name plates were made by the children to depict this concept.

The children were fascinated with the story of **Moshe's birth and his life in the palace. We spoke about the emunah of his mother Yocheved and his sister Miriam and how they were not afraid to disobey Paroh's terrible decree.** The children learned that Moshe ran away from Mitzrayim to Midian. There he married Tziporah. When Hashem spoke to him as he stood near **the burning bush and told him to lead B'nei Yisroel out of slavery,** he immediately went back to Mitzrayim to lead **B'nei Yisroel.**

We are learning the letters kaf, chaf and chaf sofis. The children were taught that the chaf sofis can only come at the end of a word. Some of the vocabulary words that were taught this week were **כלב, כדור, כסא, כפה, כובע, כוס, כתר, כחול, כתום**. We also reviewed the sentences:

PRE-KI, II & III- MOROT BERNEY & JUDY

**This week, the letter "Ff" found its way into the Pre-K classrooms.** We played lots of fun games. We **looked for items beginning with the letter "F" and brainstormed as many words as we could think of.** We **decorated the letter "Ff" with feathers and listened to many "Ff" stories including The Foot Book by Dr. Suess and Franklin Is Bossy by Paulette Bourgeois.** We **learned a poem about "Five Freckled Frogs" and acted it out.** We also had a fantastic frog race. We pretended to be frogs as we leaped across the carpet.

Our science experiments involved floating and sinking. We placed a variety of objects in water and observed which items float and which sink.

Our unit on the properties of air is quite enlightening. This week, we did experiments to prove that a candle needs air in order to stay lit and that air takes up space. Ask your child what happened.

We are very excited about our unit on Art Appreciation. Each week, we focus on a different artist. To date, we have learned about George Seurat, Piet **Mondrian, Henri Matisse and Claude Monet.** We've had such fun experimenting and replicating their artistic styles. This week, we learned about Marc Chagall. We talked about the stained glass windows that he made for Hadassah Hospital and of course, made our own version of the stained glass windows.



## KINDERGARTEN I & II- MOROT BAYLA & RENA

The yeladim have become so much more aware of the brachos that they make on food as our brachos unit continues to evolve. The bracha **בורא מיני מזונות** was featured this week. We enjoyed activities such as baking and decorating cupcakes and cookies. Many new words were added to our growing Hebrew vocabulary such as oogah, oogiyot, kemach and sukar. We also practiced saying **“Ima ofah oogah”** and **“Yalda ofa oogah”**. We made beautiful cake plates that will grace our Shabbos table.

We enjoyed hearing the story Adventures In Bracha Land by Bracha Rishona. Of course, our culminating activity was a delicious mezonos snack. Thank you once again for sending in foods for our mezonos snack.

**Although next week is when “Farmer Jones” comes to visit to teach us about the brachos of “Borei Pri Ha’adamah” and “Borei Pri Ha’eitz”, we planted our marigold seeds this week so that the plants will be ready for Tu B’Shevat. We were very careful as we planted them and we can’t wait until we see them sprout and grow.**

**A new nekudah, the “segol” was added as Mrs. Funny Face acquired two eyes and a nose. She was busy cooking Shabbos eggs and we practiced combining the “eh” with the letters to say “eh, beh, geh...”**

We were excited to start the next Sefer in the Torah– Sefer Shemos. We heard about the hardships that Bnei Yisroel had experienced in Mitzrayim. We heard how **Moshe was saved by Batya, Paroh’s daughter and how he was raised by her. Though Moshe had all of the luxuries of living in Paroh’s palace, he always concerned himself with his fellow Jews.** The children were amazed to hear that Hashem appeared to him in a burning bush and told him that he was chosen to be the leader to take the Jews out of Mitzrayim. We enjoyed listening to the story A Little Girl Named Miriam by Dina Rosenfeld.

In our Project Derech Program, we learned that it is wrong to argue with a parent.

## KINDERGARTEN I & II- MOROT BERNEY & MIRIAM

What a terrific week we had filled with all kinds of **tremendous activities. “Tt” was our letter of the week.** With our newly acquired ability to recognize the letter **“Tt”, we were able to read many new words from the “at” family (cat, sat etc.) and the “ot” family (cot, lot, got etc.)** We even read complete sentences such as **“The cat got a tag”, “A dog is lost”.** In the **“Tt” letterbook, we read our first story entitled “Tag.”** The children were truly excited to be able to read. Please review this story with your child when the letterbooks are sent home.

In centers, we had a terrific time playing tic-tac-toe. We even made up a new version of the game. We wrote words in each of the spaces. Three correct words in a row would win, of course.

In the listening center, the children listened to the story The Tiny Seed by Eric Carle\_ and also heard the same book read as a big book by the teachers.

**In honor of “Tt” week, we began a unit on transportation.** We talked about vehicles which travel on land, over water and through air. We discussed how anything that is used for transportation needs some kind of energy input for fuel.

In Science, we continued our unit on magnets. This week, we did experiments showing that magnetic attraction can pass through materials such as paper, water, glass and fabric.

Our kindergarteners are really working with rhyming words. Each class has made a big book with illustrated rhyming sentences. We will exhibit these books during the parent/teacher conferences in January.


