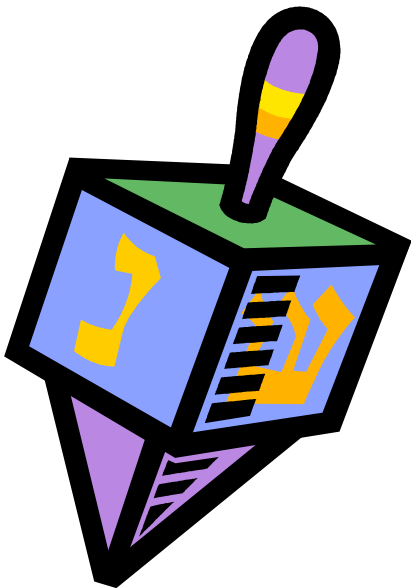
NURSERY I & II- MOROT ETTIE & TAMI

For Parashas Vayeshev, we spoke about **Yosef's coat of many colors as well as his life in Mitzrayim**. We heard how Yosef was put in jail where he interpreted the dreams of the other prisoners. Through Parashas Vayeshev, we learned a very important lesson –that jealousy is a negative character trait. The story **Sometimes I'm Jealous** by Jane Watson was read to the children to help them understand the concept of jealousy.

As we continued focusing on the story of Chanukah, we learned new Hebrew vocabulary words and phrases:

NURSERY I & II- MOROT NECHAMA & SUSAN

Our Nursery class had a lovely week filled with exciting activities. A new unit on Animals That Live in the Water was introduced in class. We looked at pictures of the many different animals that live in the water and created pictures of whales in the ocean. Mixing paints to simulate the appearance of water was lots of fun. We also made a starfish and a seahorse.

We learned a new finger play entitled "Where Is Fishy?"

(wave hands)

We listened to several stories about fish, whales, dolphins and sharks. We also enjoyed listening to the stories Froggy Goes To School, Froggy Bakes A Cake and Froggy Goes To Bed by Jonathan London and Rainbow Fish And The Big Blue Whale by Marcus Pfister.



PRE-KI & II- MOROT ETTIE & HEIDI

In Parashas Vayeshev, we learned about Yosef and his brothers and how they were jealous of Yosef. We talked about their feelings towards Yosef and realized that although we may all feel jealous at times, it is important to be aware of it and realize that Hashem gives every person different things and that there is always something in our lives to be happy about. We decided we will try to be happy for our friends and change a negative feeling into something good through sharing.

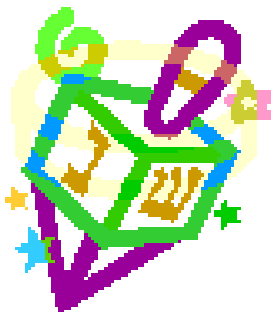
Our Hebrew letter this week is the letter ט. Some of the vocabulary words that we learned in conjunction with this letter were

מה זה? זה שמש



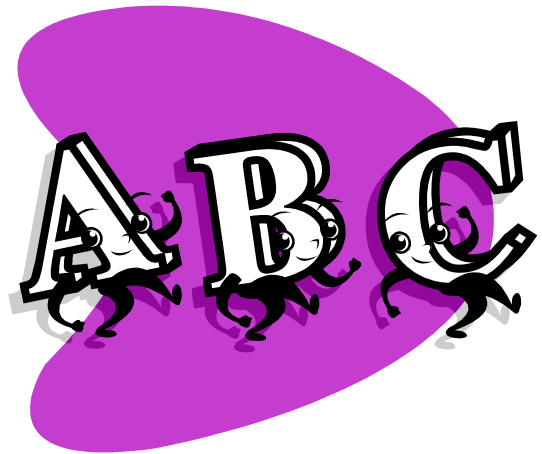
PRE-KI & II-MORAH JUDY

This week, the Pre-K children continued their unit on Famous Artists. They learned about the techniques of the painter Monet who was an impressionist. Words that relate to Monet's art are: light, shadow, landscape, reflection, sunrise and nature. We discussed nature, water, wind and waves and how these elements were reflected in his paintings. A famous painting that we looked at was "Waterloo Bridge." The children sang the song "London Bridge" as they constructed their own bridges. They also joined in a favorite music and movement song by "Rafi" called "Across The Bridge."

This week we reviewed the letters "Aa" and "Bb" and introduced the letter "Cc". The children sounded out words such as cat, caterpillar, car, coat, clock, colors and candy.

The children in Pre-K practiced their number recognition skills through games and activities. They also counted with cuisinaire rods.

The stories that the children listened to this week were Katie Visits The Impressionists by James Mayhew and The Very Hungry Caterpillar by Eric Carle.



KINDERGARTEN I, II & III-MOROT BAYLA AND RENA

The excitement is mounting as Chag HaChanukah is almost here. This week, all of our activities focused on Chanukah. The children learned about the great miracles which Hashem performed for us-how the tiny army of the Maccabim was victorious over the stronger Greek army and how the kad shemen which had enough oil to burn for only one day, burned instead for eight days and nights. We learned when, where and how to light the chanukiah. We also discussed the minhagim of eating foods cooked in oil and playing dreidle. We learned about two great women, Chana and Yehudis, who sacrificed themselves for Kiddush Hashem.

We spent some time reviewing the letters alef through ches and blending them with the patach, kamatz and segol.

In our D'vash V'chalav program, we asked and answered the question:

כמה נרות יש במנורה?
יש נר אחד
יש שני נרות

And learned the phrases:

זה שמש
זה שמן זית

Of course, we know that the letters on the סביבון stand for:

נס גדול היה שם

For Parashas Vayeshev, we heard about the special Kesones Pasim that Yosef received from Yaakov. We discussed Yosef's dream and how this all led up to Yosef being sold as a slave in Mitzrayim. Though we felt very sad for Yosef, we discussed how everything is a plan from Hashem and how this was the way for Hashem to bring B'nai Yisrael to Mitzrayim.

For Project Derech, we learned that it is wrong to shame any person.



KINDERGARTEN I, II & III- MOROT BERNEY & HEIDI

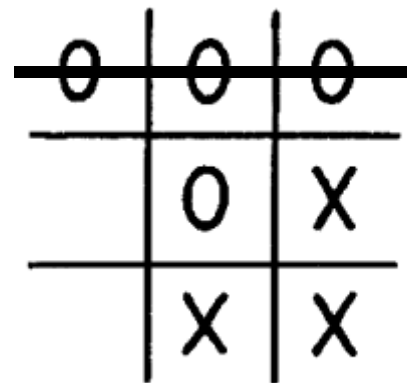
