## NURSERY – MORAH TAMI

The Nursery children loved hearing the many beautiful midrashim about the life of Moshe Rabbenu-how he was placed in a teivas gomeh by his mother, Yocheved, and hidden in the river amongst the tall reeds. As Miriam watched her brother Moshe, Batya, the daughter of Paroh came down to the river and saw Moshe crying. She reached out her hand and Hashem made a nes occur. Her hand stretched all the way to the teivah. We also learned how Bnei Yisroel became slaves and how Moshe Rabbenu was commanded by Hashem to lead Bnei Yisroel out of Mitzrayim. The children acted out the parsha and pretended to be slaves. They built the cities of Pitom and Ramses and **sang the song "Bang, Bang, hold Your Hammers Low."**

Bang, bang, bang, Hold your hammers low  
Bang, bang, bang, give a heavy blow  
**For it's work, work, work**  
Every day and every night (2x)  
Dig, dig, dig, your shovels deep  
Dig, dig, dig, there is no time to sleep.

**Our unit on winter was the focus of the week's** activities in the Nursery class. We talked about weather and **sang the song "Miami Has No Sheleg:"**

Miami has no sheleg  
No snow to roll and throw  
**Up north, where the weather's cold**  
**That's where you'll find snow.**

New Hebrew vocabulary words taught this week included the words kar, kefafot, tzaif and magafaim. The following Hebrew phrases were also taught this week:

For our Hebrew language unit focusing on food vocabulary, the children were introduced to the following phrases:

## NURSERY - MORAH SUSAN

This week, we began a unit on the sense of taste. We listened to the stories Growing Vegetable Soup by Lois Ehlert, Taste by Marcia Ruis, The Hungry thing Returns by Jan Slepian, A Tasting Party by Jane Belk Moncure and Tasting Things by Allan Fowler. We learned that the taste buds on our tongues give us our sense of taste.

During center time, we had a wonderful tasting party. We had a chance to taste salty pretzels, sweet candy, sour pickles and bitter lemons all with our taste buds.

The children have been busy at the art center creating a mouth with a long tongue. They used markers to draw dots all over the tongue to represent their taste buds.

During circle time, we learned a new fingerplay:

### The Beehive

Here are the beehives  
(make two fists)  
Where are all the bees?  
Hiding away where nobody sees  
Here they are  
(wiggle fingers)  
They are all alive  
One, two, three, four, five.

The concept of one to one correspondence of object to object was introduced this week.. The children practiced setting the table with each child receiving one napkin, one plate, one fork and one spoon. Once the children understand the concept of one to one correspondence, they can link numbers with the appropriate number of objects.



PRE-KI, II & III- MOROT ETTIE & HEIDI

This week, in Parashas Shemos, we learned that Bnei Yisroel didn't change their Jewish names while they were in Mitzrayim. The children were fascinated with the story of Moshe's birth and his life in the palace. We spoke about the emunah of his mother, Yocheved and his sister, Miriam, and how they were not afraid to disobey Paroh's terrible decree. The children learned that Moshe ran away from Mitzrayim to Midyan. In Midyan, Moshe married Tziporah. When Hashem spoke to Moshe as he stood near the burning bush, Hashem told him to lead Bnei Yisroel out of slavery and back to Eretz Yisroel.

We are continuing our unit on Brachos. The children are enjoying playing various games to reinforce saying the correct bracha over specific foods.

Our Hebrew letter this week is yud. Vocabulary words that we learned are:

PRE-KI, II & III-MOROT JUDY & NECHAMA

We continued our unit on the Properties of Air. This week, we discussed that air is everywhere and that it is invisible. Our planet is surrounded by air, even though we cannot see it. We did an experiment to prove that a candle needs air in order to stay lit.

The children also experimented with an air blowing machine. They experienced air pressure and they saw how air can lift objects up into the air. Feathers, cotton balls, pom poms and tissues were lifted into the air by the air pressure coming from the air machine. Heavy items would not lift up easily. The children were excited to discover that although air can fill up many objects such as a ball, a bag, a balloon and a tire, it has no weight. Even though we cannot see the air, we can feel it on our skin. We also had a great time creating fans.

The letter "Ee" was introduced this week. The children sounded out many "Ee" words such as elephant, eggs, empty and exit. We searched around school to find exit signs. We added up the number of exit signs and spoke about the importance of those signs. "Ee" friends in our Pre-K classes include Efraim and Esther.

A favorite Raffi counting song that we sang for the letter "Ee" was "One Elephant Went Out To Play."

One elephant went out to play  
On a spider's web one day  
He had such enormous fun  
That he asked another elephant to come

(Each time another elephant joined the song, another child would join the circle)

Favorite "Ee" books this week were Ella The Elegant Elephant and Ella Takes The Cake both by Carmela and Steven D'amico.

Mr. Maya came to Pre-K this week. He spoke about construction. It was exciting for the Pre-K children to learn about building equipment and tools. They have been observing the construction of the new Toras Emes building. They learned new words such as foreman, cement truck, electric saws, power tools and blueprints.

## KINDERGARTEN I, II & III-MOROT BAYLA AND RENA

This week, we continued our unit on Brachos. Almonds, pistachios, cashews, olives, apricots, peaches and plums joined their friends the apples, oranges, **grapefruits, kiwis and more to form the Boreh Pre Ha'etz** group. We marveled at the miracle of a seed growing into a tree which can produce such delicious and nutritious fruit; each one packaged in a colorful wrapping to protect their fruit.

We enjoyed listening to the book Shimmee And The Taste Me Tree by Sheindel Weinbach which emphasizes these concepts.

Thank you for sending in the foods for our bracha party. We hope you enjoy the fruit bowl that we made. We also learned two Hebrew phrases in conjunction with this unit:

ילד אוכל תפוז  
ילדה אוכלת תפוח

We reviewed the letters alef through yud with our three nekudos (kamatz, patach and tzereh) and introduced the letters kaf and chaf. We did a lot of practice with them to make sure that we did not mix them up with the bais and vais. We were surprised to see how many Hebrew words starts with a kaf.

We were excited to start the next Sefer in the Torah– Sefer Shemos. We heard about the hardships that Bnei Yisroel had experienced in Mitzrayim. We **heard how Moshe was saved by Batya, Paroh's daughter**, and how he was raised by her. Through **Moshe had all of the luxuries of living in Paroh's palace**, he always concerned himself with his fellow Jews. The children were amazed to hear that Hashem appeared to him in a burning bush and told him that he was chosen to be the leader to take the Jews out of Mitzrayim. We enjoyed listening to the story A Little Girl Named Miriam by Dina Rosenfeld.

In our Project Derech Program, we learned that it is wrong to argue with a parent.

## KINDERGARTEN I, II & III– MOROT BERNEY & HEIDI

**This week, we finished our “Ff” letterbooks and began learning about the letter “Ee”.** Some of the new word families we learned were led, Ted, fed, sled; tell, fell; get, set, wet and let.

The children are having a wonderful time experimenting with magnets. We are continuing to find out new and exciting facts about what makes magnets work (and not work).

**Mrs. Blejer is continuing her “read-a-loud” program and the children are very enthusiastic about “reading” the big books on their own.**

In math, we have practiced writing the numbers 7, 8 and 9. The children are also learning how to combine different sets of numbers that can be added together to get the same sum.

**In honor of Tu B'Shevat, we began a new unit on plants and seeds.** We will be planting in our own special kindergarten garden that will be located near the playground. We are very excited to plant, water and watch our garden grow!

Dear Parents,

I had the privilege to be part of a panel of speakers last night at a community event at The Shul of Bal Harbour, sponsored by Ohel and the Yehi Or division of Jewish Community Services of Miami-Dade, discussing how to raise healthy and resilient children. In my remarks, my focus was on the school's role in raising healthy, resilient children and supporting a healthy home. By sharing my ideas with you, I hope for the ultimate benefit of our students, your children.

In order for there to be a healthy partnership between home and school that works for the benefit of the children, there are mutual expectations that are necessary and appropriate.

**The parents have the right to expect the following of their child's school:**

- A commitment to help every child succeed in school
- A concern for the entire child – more than just academics
- To promote and protect the child's physical and emotional well-being
- Is forthright in sharing objective information (Resists tendency and pressure to gloss over problems)
- Is responsive to parents' concerns
- Engages in supportive, collaborative problem-solving

**The school has the right to expect the following from their students' parents:**

- To support school's efforts – be a partner, not an adversary; recognize you're both on the same team
- No badmouthing of the school – share concerns with those who can help the situation
- Be forthright – don't withhold information until there's an "explosion." Share information about an emerging challenge. Be open about past issues that may still be relevant.
- Be responsive to school's suggestions – seek outside help when recommended
- Have patience for measures to have an effect – the challenge may have built up over years – it will not disappear overnight. Treasure small gains.

The key to our children's success in school is **trust** between parents and school. Trust needs to be earned, but it will happen a lot easier and quicker, if each side judges the other favorably, recognizing that they both sincerely have the child's best interest in mind.
